

PanAm Building (now MetLife building), Walter Gropius, 1963




IDS Centre, Philip Johnson, 1972

LATE '50s TO EARLY '70s

Rachel Carson's **Silent Spring**, 1962

 Focussed on pesticide use and its adverse impact on the environment

 Human activities and its relationship with the environment was examined





- 1963: Designing with Climate (Olgyay and Olgyay)
- 1967: Sun, Wind, Water (Ralph Knowles)
- 1968: Form and Stability (Ralph Knowles)
- 1970: First Earth Day



...BACK IN AUSTRALIA

- 1970-74: Green Bans in Australia
 - Kelly's Bush, Hunters Hill
 - The Rocks precinct
 - Royal Botanical Gardens
- 1977: Heritage Act
- 1979: Environmental Planning and Assessment Act (EP&A)

- 1973: OPEC Oil Embargo
 - October '73 to March '74
- 1979: Oil Crisis
 - 12 months



1983-87: World Commission on Environment and Development released 'Our Common Future' (Brundtland Report), which defined **Sustainable Development** as:

 A development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs

- 1985: Vienna Convention for protection of Ozone Layer
- 1987: Montreal Protocol for substances that deplete Ozone Layer
- 1990: Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) - First Assessment Report


- 1992: UN Earth Summit in Rio
 - Agenda 21 (Sustainable Development)
 - Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC)
- 1997: UNFCCC Kyoto Protocol

- Infrastructure Sustainability (Infrastructure Sustainability Council of Australia)
- LEED (US Green Building Council)
- BREEAM (UK Building Research Establishment)
- Living Building Challenge
- One Planet Living
- WELL Building Standard



- Established 2002 to develop sustainable property industry in Australia
- Authority on sustainable buildings and communities
- Ratings, advocacy and research
- Not for profit
- Member-based organisation

- Independent third party certification
- Locally and internationally recognised and well-respected

RATING SCALE



WELL BUILDING STANDARD



- Established in 2013
- FIRST human health and wellness building standard
- Over 7 years of evidence-based medical and scientific research



- Developed by DELOS
- Ex-Wall Street executive (including Goldman Sachs)
- Interested in Sustainability and altruistic capitalism



- Administered by International WELL Building Institute (IWBI)
- IWBI is a public benefit corporation (B-Corp)
- Delos licensed IWBI to administer WELL Building Standard




- Not a rating system but a Nutrition Label for buildings and fitouts
- Ingredients for a healthy building or fitouts



- Over 100 performance metrics, design strategies and policies
- Requirements are embedded in design and then performance-tested on-site by third party





- Complements and works seamlessly with:
 - Green Star
 - LEED
 - Living Building Challenge
- Can also be a standalone system
